Arrival

I assume most people are arriving on a flight plan, either VFR or IFR, and there is no need for PPR. I would though ask that you notify us of your plans, so they can arrange parking!

Standard IFR approach for one of the ILS' or PBN. If they are on RWY 29, it will be circling to land, as the PBN approach interferes with Kastrup Airport. They may offer a visual approach, but I would stick to IFR to make life easy, if you're not familiar.

If you arrive VFR, just be mindful of the airspace and change over to Roskilde Approach before entering the zone - Class C extends out quite a far way. There are VRPs that they will want you to use. Borup or Koge are probably the relevant points for most of you. Please be mindful of noise abatement: http://aim.naviair.dk/
